Tachi Yamada Scholarship Program

OFFICIAL RULES:

The Tachi Yamada Scholarship Program ("Scholarship Program" or "Program") for the 2024 award begins on March 5, 2024, at 7:00:00 a.m. Eastern Time ("ET") and ends on April 26, 2024, at 11:59:59 p.m. ET. Sponsor's computer is the official timekeeping device for this Scholarship Program.

By participating, each participant agrees to abide by these Official Rules and decisions of Passage Bio, Inc. ("Sponsor"), which shall be final and binding in all respects to the Scholarship Program.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The Scholarship Program was created to honor the personal and professional contributions of Dr. Tachi Yamada to the life sciences industry in Pennsylvania by providing cash to eligible college juniors pursuing degrees in the life sciences at colleges and universities in Pennsylvania.

The Scholarship Program will provide one rising junior attending a four-year college/university undergraduate program at an accredited school in Pennsylvania with a \$10,000 scholarship award (\$5,000 per year for junior and senior year).

In addition, the Scholar will receive exposure to the life sciences industry through a Passage Bio mentor and participation in Life Sciences Pennsylvania events over the course of the two-year scholarship award period.

The Scholarship Program is open to college sophomores who meet all eligibility requirements stated below.

TERM:

This Scholarship Program for 2024 is only for one selected sophomore in 2024 and will end after selection of a recipient in accordance with these Official Rules. Sponsor retains the right to discontinue the Scholarship Program at any time. Any future Scholarship Program will be subject to future announcements and future Official Rules.

ELIGIBILITY:

The Scholarship Program is open to students ("Eligible Students" or "Students") who meet the following eligibility requirements:

"Scholar" is a highly driven student who excels in the classroom, has a focused interest and passion for the life sciences industry and intends to enter the life sciences industry upon graduation.

Qualified sophomores/rising juniors are defined as:

• Attending a PA-based four-year college/university undergraduate program and enrolled in a life sciences major (e.g., biomedical, biotechnology, chemistry, pharmacy, etc.)

- Excelling in the classroom, with a focused interest and passion for the life sciences industry and intending to enter the life sciences industry upon graduation
- Having and maintaining a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher for the entire duration of the scholarship
- · Living as either a US citizen, permanent resident of the US, or holding a US student visa
- · Willing to attend two events in the Philadelphia area per year, to be approved by their Passage Bio mentor
- Delivering an essay by Friday, April 26th, 2024 along with a completed application

Children or wards of (a) employees, officers and Board members of Sponsor and their affiliates, agents or representatives; (b) Program's advertising and promotion agencies, if any, as well as (c) household members of (a) and (b), whether or not related, are not eligible to receive Scholarships as part of this Scholarship Program.

- · Proof of Grade Point Average
- · Proof of enrollment for the junior year of college located in Pennsylvania
- Proof of major in life sciences field
- · Transcript from all colleges/universities
- Resume
- · Two letters of reference from professors commenting on your academic performance and engagement with scientific subject matter

Affidavit of Eligibility, Waiver and Consent: Once all documents have been submitted, the applicant must digitally sign an affidavit of eligibility and any other applicable waivers to be awarded the Scholarship. The applicants will also be asked to digitally sign a publicity release.

If the applicant cannot be contacted as provided herein after the first attempt to contact them, if they fail to sign and return any required documents by the timeline as requested by the Sponsor, or if the applicant is disqualified for any reason, which decision shall be based on the Sponsor's sole discretion, the applicant/potential recipient forfeits the Scholarship. In such an event, the Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, award the Scholarship to an alternate recipient selected by the Sponsor, in its sole discretion.

PRIVACY:

SELECTION OF RECIPIENT:

The applicants will be reviewed by a panel of Sponsor's employees and the selection will be made by Sponsor, in its sole discretion. All decisions made by Sponsor shall be final and non-appealable.

On or before May 10, 2024, Sponsor will select the name of the recipient of the Scholarship.

NOTIFICATION OF POTENTIAL RECIPIENT:

The potential recipient will be notified by email by May 15, 2024.

VERIFICATION OF POTENTIAL RECIPIENT:

A PARTICIPANT IS NOT A RECIPIENT OF ANY SCHOLARSHIP UNLESS AND UNTIL PARTICIPANT'S ELIGIBILITY HAS BEEN VERIFIED AND PARTICIPANT HAS BEEN NOTIFIED THAT VERIFICATION IS COMPLETE.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY:
